

## INDIRECT OBJECTS

### SLR viewfinder and film

First, cut all solid lines. For the top of the camera, fold only along the dotted line. Fold it away from you so it rests level with the horizon. You can now look at that horizon through your viewfinder. If you reject the one you see, gently bounce the top of the camera a little and you can make a new paper horizon. That's technology.

Roll up the narrow shutter strip toward you to make a button, and tie a length of string through the strap holes.

For the film, lay it down grey side up, roll up the straight end, and secure with a small paper clip to form a film cassette.
